

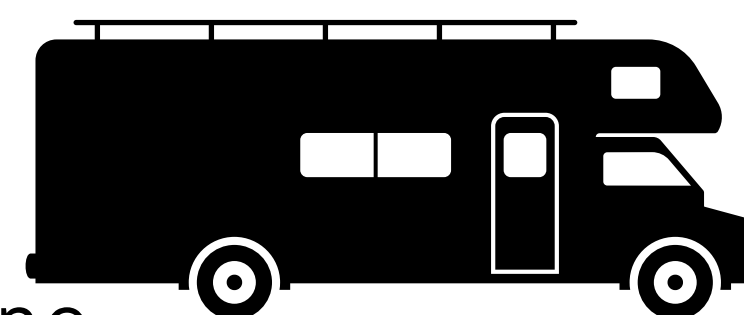
OVERSIZED VEHICLE ORDINANCE ENFORCEMENT AND EDUCATION

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

NO PARKING 2 A.M. - 6 A.M.

All non-motorized, recreational and other oversized (exceeding 27 feet and 7 feet high) vehicles City-wide.

EDUCATION & SERVICES OFFERED FIRST



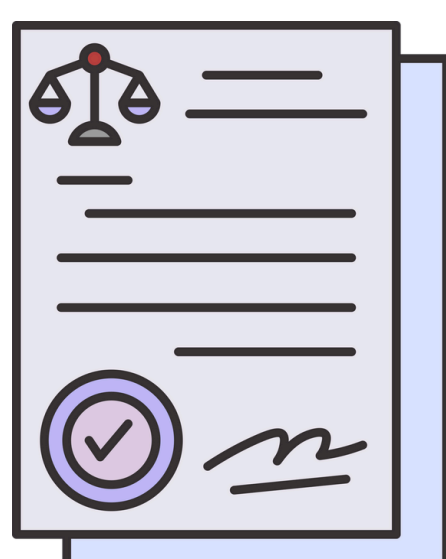
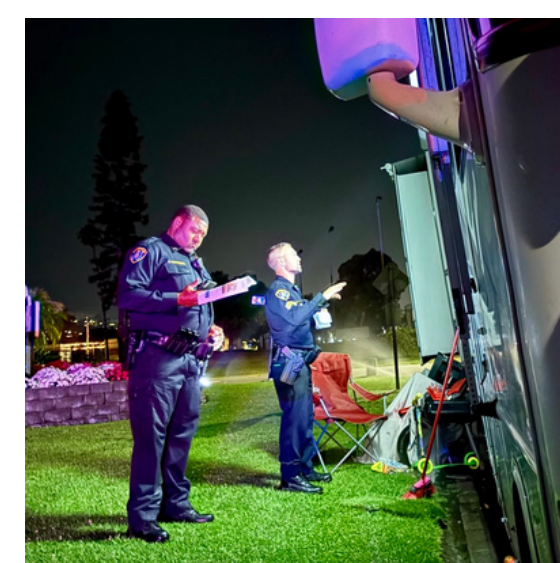
Individuals living in vehicles offered immediate placement into Safe Parking Program. H Barracks lot near airport accepts overnight police referrals.

SDPD's Neighborhood Policing Division conducted outreach to people living in vehicles prior to enforcement starting in the beach communities.

REFUSAL/ABANDONED VEHICLE = ENFORCEMENT

July - September 1,136 Oversized Vehicle Ordinance citations issued, plus 2,995 other citations for violations of posted signs, 72-hour rule, etc. Focus remains on beach areas (most complaints).

245 referrals to the City's Safe Parking Program.



BLOOM SETTLEMENT

2024 legal settlement created new standards for how oversized vehicle parking enforcement is conducted.

Safe Parking must be available during enforcement, compassionate approach with focus on connections to services.
